- Data Descriptions

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Study 1: State Emotions

S1 ~ S25: Personal Moral Scenarios #

S1_1: choice

: '0' appropriate, '1' inappropriate

S1_2: emotions that participants reported

: '1' anger '2' sadness '3' fear '4' anxiety '5' disgust

'6' guilt '7' shame '8' surprise '9' empathy

Study 2: Trait Emotions

SG: Shame and Guilt

TA: Anger

D: Disgust

ET: Empathy

S: Scenarios

: 1' appropriate '2' inappropriate

Numbers mean item numbers.

ex) D7 means Disgust scale item number seven.

Independent variables

: GuiltO, ShameO, EmpathyO, AngerO, DisgustO (mean of all items)

: Guilt, Shame, Empathy, Anger, Disgust (standardized z score)

Dependent variables

: Stotal (counting number for all 25 scenarios 'appropriate' answers)

: Stotal21 (counting number for the ones Koenigs et al. (2007) used: 21 scenarios)
